Customer Advisory: Mundra Port activities badly affected due to weather conditions

Dear Valued Customer,

Heavy rainfall in Gujarat and Rajasthan has caused breaches on the railway route to Mundra Port, affecting rail movement in those areas. Mundra Port operations and movement by road are slowly going back to normal.

The following are complete details for your reference:

1. Railway track has been badly affected due to heavy rain at the following places in Ahmedabad Division.
 - BHABHAR (BAH) – MITHA (MITA) – 7.4 Kms
 - SAMAKHIALI JN (SIOB) – BHACHAU (BCOB) - 15.96 Kms
 - Gandhidham - Palanpur section of ADI division is also severely water logged.
 - As SIOB is the interchange point for all inward & outward rakes of Mundra, the movement of rakes to/from Mundra has been stopped until the track can be restored..
2. Ajmer route is closed until further advice due to heavy rain and ballast wash out.
3. Trains are running towards Mundra from ICD Locations – Dadri, Tughlakabad , Alik, Jaipur, Jodpur, Moradabad, Patli, Loni, Garhi, Faridabad, Kota, Khodiaya, Sahanawal and Sonipat.
4. Railways have imposed restriction for two days on loading of all goods traffic for Mundra and Gandhidham area via Samakhyali.
